2009 Les Schwab Bowl – Players To Watch

Portland, Oregon –The Les Schwab Bowl will be played Saturday night, June 20th at Hillsboro Stadium and will showcase Oregon's best 5A/6A graduated football players from around the State. Doors open at 6:00pm and kickoff will be at 7:30pm. Tickets are now on sale for the 2009 Les Schwab Bowl exclusively at www.LesSchwabBowl.com.

With a game that has spanned over 60 years, there have been a lot of future NFL and college stars participate in the Les Schwab Bowl. Some of the recent Les Schwab Bowl players who are currently playing in the NFL include: Joey Harrington (New Orleans Saints), Quintin Mikell (Philadelphia Eagles), Legedu Naanee (San Diego Chargers), Jordan Senn (Indianapolis Colts), and Roy Schuening (St. Louis Rams).

This year's Les Schwab Bowl will highlight the state's best high school football players and feature numerous Division I recruits and more than 50 future college players. Here are some of the Players to Watch for the 2009 Les Schwab Bowl:

North:

Jack Lomax: Oregon's 6A Offensive Player of the Year will quarterback the North Team. As a senior at Lake Oswego, Lomax threw for over 3,700 yards and 46 touchdowns and was selected Most Valuable Player in the TRL. Lomax is the son of former NFL quarterback, Neil Lomax and will attend Oregon State University on a full scholarship.

Malcolm Johnson: Johnson is a dynamic back from Barlow High School who rushed for more than 2,100 yards his senior season. He is a three-time recipient of 1st Team All-State honors and was featured in Sports Illustrated "Faces in the Crowd" after exploding for 458 yards and five touchdowns against Centennial. He will attend Boise State University next year on a full scholarship.

Micah Hatfield: Hatfield was selected 1st Team All-State as both a wide receiver and a defensive back during his senior year at Lake Oswego. He will attend Oregon State University on a full scholarship.

Anthony Blake: Blake attended Jesuit High School and finished the year with nearly 1,900 rushing yards and was a 1st Team All-State selection. He plans to attend the College of Holy Cross next year.

Paul Tuma: Tuma, a defensive lineman from Southridge had a dominating senior season in which he was named the 6A Defensive Player of the Year. Tuma was the heart of a defense which held opponents to an average of 12.4 points per game en route to the 6A State Championship. He will attend Western Oregon University next year to continue his football career.

South:

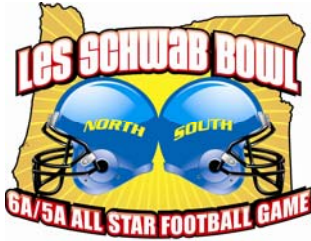
Tym Pearson: The South Team will be led by quarterback Tym Pearson, Oregon's 5A Offensive Player of the Year. As a senior, Pearson passed for over 3,700 yards, 44 touchdowns, and ran for nearly 900 yards. Tym will play football at Portland State University on a full scholarship.

Matt McHenry: Heading the South Team's defense will be 5A Defensive Player of the Year Matt McHenry. McHenry, from West Albany High School, won two consecutive State Championships and was dominant force as a linebacker.

Taylor Hart: Hart, from Tualatin was selected 6A 1st Team All-State as both an offensive and defensive linemen. He received a full scholarship from the University of Oregon and will play football for the Ducks next season.

Charles Siddoway: Siddoway was regarded as the top recruit in the state of Oregon during the 2008 football season. He was selected 2nd Team All-State as an offensive lineman and will be attending the University of California Berkeley on a full scholarship.

John Braun: Braun is a talented lineman from West Albany who was a key factor in West Albany's consecutive 5A State Championships. During his junior and senior seasons, he was named 1st Team All-State and 1st Team All-League as both an offensive tackle and a defensive end. He will be attending Oregon State University next year on a full scholarship to play football for the Beavers.

Michael Beaton: Beaton is a talented two-way lineman from Dallas High School who received a full scholarship from Oregon State University to play football.
