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Tickets and Tournament Passes now on sale for 12th Annual Les Schwab Invitational *presented by Fred Meyer*

Entering its twelfth year, this nationally-recognized tournament brings players from elite high school programs to Oregon to match up against the state's best local teams. The 2007 LSI will feature the #1 ranked prospect in the country, 6' 10" Greg Monroe from Helen Cox High School. Monroe has as much upside as any prospect in the 2008 class and may have more ability than any other player in this class. He can score in a variety of ways, handles the ball and passes like a guard while blocking shots and rebounding in the manner in which one would expect from an interior player. He recently committed to play at Georgetown University next year. Archbishop Mitty of San Jose, CA also featured a highly touted prospect in 6-8 power forward Drew Gordon who just signed a letter of intent to play at UCLA next year. The state of Oregon will also have its share of future division I talent represented in the tournament with such stars as Oregon City's Brad Tinsley (Pepperdine), South Medford's Michael Harthun (Washington State), Grant's Paul McCoy (Pepperdine), Westview's Andy Poling (Gonzaga) and North Eugene's Brian Conklin (St. Louis).
