This year the LSI features 4 teams ranked in ESPN's Fab 50 Preseason Rankings - #3 Oak Hill Academy, #6 Westchester, #24 Jesuit and #30 Jefferson. The first round will be played over two evenings on Saturday and Sunday December 26th and 27th. Fans can enjoy the 2nd Annual Slam Dunk / 3 Pt. Contest preceding Session #2 from 1-3 pm on the 27th. The evening session begins at 4:00pm with games running every hour and a half.
