



### **2006 Les Schwab Bowl Update**

The 2006 Les Schwab Bowl will take place Friday night, June 23<sup>rd</sup> at PGE Park in Portland. The 72 players and 12 Coaches are extremely excited to have the opportunity to participate in the game. The Les Schwab Bowl is an Oregon tradition that enters its 59<sup>th</sup> year as Oregon's North vs. South high school all-star football game (formerly known as the Shrine Game and more recently, the Oregon Bowl). All players will check-in at Lewis & Clark College on June 17<sup>th</sup> and begin practicing and preparing for their final prep football game under the lights at PGE Park at 7:00 on the 23<sup>rd</sup>.

All of the players have been working hard to sell game tickets as well as game program ads to reach their goal of raising \$500 towards the game and its charities – the Oregon Athletic Coaches Association's general scholarship fund, YMCA Youth Activities League scholarships, and the Multnomah Athletic Foundation. It is important for the young men to learn the value of giving back to the communities that have supported them throughout their high school careers.

Players will be housed at Lewis & Clark the week prior to the game where they will practice twice a day on the school's football field. Each night, the players and coaches will head off and do something fun to take their minds off the game like playing Laser Tag, Bowling, going to the movies or heading to Bullwinkles for mini golf, batting cages, go-kart rides or video games. The week is culminated by the Player's Banquet the night before the game at the Multnomah Athletic Club.
