2007 LES SCHWAB BOWL TEAMS SELECTED

PORTLAND, OR -- The **Les Schwab Bowl** is proud to announce the players selected to play in the state's 2007 6A/5A high school All-Star football game. 2007 marks the 60th Anniversary of the game and the 10th year since the game switched from the Shrine Game to the Les Schwab Bowl. In 2007, due to the OSAA's reclassification, the Les Schwab Bowl features the top-graduating seniors from Oregon's 5A and 6A high schools. The North squad draws talent from the PIL, Metro, Mt. Hood, Three Rivers, and Northwest leagues while the South squad is made up of players from the Pacific, Southwest, Central Valley, Mid-Willamette, Midwestern, Southern Sky and Intermountain leagues. The 2007 Les Schwab Bowl will be played at PGE Park in Portland on Friday night, June 22nd. Kickoff for the game is slated for 7:00 p.m. Southridge High School coach Brad Mastrud will coach the North squad after leading his team to a state championship appearance last December. They will be led by quarterback Connor Kavanaugh of Lincoln and Oregon's 6A Defensive Player of the Year Kevin Frahm of Central Catholic. The North Squad will also feature the state's number one recruit in defensive tackle Myles Wade who recently signed a letter of intent to play for the Ducks next year. Chris McGowen, head coach of the 5A State Champion Corvallis Spartans will direct the South Squad. They will be led by quarterback / defensive back Jake Haberly of West Albany, the 5A Player of the Year and wide receiver Aaron Pflugrad of Sheldon. Reserved tickets will be available to purchase through the players, while general admission will be available at the PGE Park Box office on 20th and Morrison as well as all TicketMaster locations.

Les Schwab Bowl proceeds benefit the Oregon Athletic Coaches Association general scholarship fund and all of Oregon's 5A and 6A schools. The OACA represents over 3000 members/coaches involving all OSAA sanctioned sports. Oregon's 5A and 6A high schools will be able to sell tickets to the Les Schwab Bowl and keep 100% of the proceeds. Charitable work is done through a partnership with the Oregon Athletic Coaches Association, Les Schwab Tires and Prime Time Sports. The OACA has been involved with the game since it's inception as the Oregon Shrine Game in 1948. This year marks the 60th anniversary of the North vs. South All-Star game.
