2nd Annual Les Schwab Shootout Set to Tip-Off Thursday, November 30th at Folsom High School!

PORTLAND, OR. (November 10, 2006) – Prime Time Sports, the marketing company for the Les Schwab Shootout, is proud to announce the field and bracket for the 2nd Annual Les Schwab Shootout. All games will take place at Folsom High School from Thursday, November 30th through Saturday, December 2nd. Each 4-game session begins at 3:30pm with games running every hour and a half. The tournament will tip-off the 2006-2007 high school basketball season with some of the top teams from the Sacramento Area competing against two national programs as well as teams from the Bay Area.

The three day tournament features two teams from outside the state of California – Montverde Academy from Orlando, FL and Jefferson High School from Portland, OR. The 2006 Les Schwab Shootout will also feature Newark Memorial High School from the Bay Area. Rounding out the field is Jesuit High School, Sacramento High School, Davis High School, Folsom High School and Woodcreek High School. During the final round (Saturday), El Cerrito High School of the Bay Area will play in Woodcreek's place.

Montverde Academy should enter the tournament ranked in the top-25 of USA Today's National Poll. Under the direction of head coach Kevin Sutton, Montverde Academy is rapidly becoming one of the top basketball programs in the country. They return 7 seniors and 2 juniors from last year's 21-8 team. They will be led by a trio of talented big men in 7-1 senior Solomon Alabi (committed to Florida St.), 6-9 senior Jean Michel Yotio (considering Central Florida and Old Dominion) and 6-11 senior Joseph Katuka (considering St. Joe's or SMU). Jefferson High School is one of the most successful basketball programs in the state of Oregon. In the past few years, Jefferson has produced a handful of top division-I talent including Aaron Miles and Mike Lee who starred for 4 years at Kansas and Thomas Gardner who had an impressive career at Missouri. Jefferson will bring an up-temp and an aggressive style of play to the tournament.

3-day tournament passes are available through participating schools and individual session tickets will be available at the Folsom High School box office on the days of the event. Individual session tickets are good for 4 games.
